

**TALLINN-TARTU GRAND PRIX 2012**  
**UCI Europe Tour cl. ME 1.1**  
**179,6 km (Tallinn-Tartu)**

**SPECIFIC REGULATIONS**

***ARTICLE 1. Organisation***

**Tallinn-Tartu GP 2012 is organised by Club Tartu Maraton** (address: 25 Laulupeo pst, 51007 Tartu, Estonia, ph. +372 7421 644, fax +372 7422 536, e-mail [indrek@tartumaraton.ee](mailto:indrek@tartumaraton.ee)) on **Friday, May 25th 2012, start at 11:00** under the Cycling Regulations of the International Cycling Union (UCI CR).

***ARTICLE 2. Type of Event, UCI Ranking Points***

The event is open to ME and MU riders. The event is registered as a UCI Europe Tour cl. ME 1.1 event. In conformity with the art. 2.11.014 of the UCI CR, UCI Europe Tour ranking points are awarded as follows: 80 – 56 – 32 – 24 – 20 – 16 – 12 – 8 – 7 – 6 – 5 – 3.

***ARTICLE 3. Participation and Registration***

**3.1. Participation**

**Tallinn-Tartu GP 2012** is open to UCI Pro Tour Teams, UCI Professional Continental Teams, UCI Continental Teams and national teams as per UCI CR art. 2.1.005.

As per UCI CR art. 2.2.003 teams must be formed of maximum 8 riders and minimum 5 riders per team. According to UCI CR art. 2.2.010 the maximum number of team support staff is equal to the number of riders.

**3.2. Registration**

Confirmation about accepting the invitation and preliminary registration on correctly filled UCI entry form should be sent by e-mail or fax or e-mail to the organiser by March 30th 2012 at the latest.

***ARTICLE 4. Race Headquarters***

The Race headquarters is open from 17:00 to 21:00 on Thursday, 24<sup>th</sup> May and from 9:00 to 10:00 on Friday, 25<sup>th</sup> May in Hotel Ülemiste (address: Lennujaama tee Str 2, Tallinn).

Team representatives are requested to confirm their starters and collect the race numbers in Hotel Ülemiste conference hall (address: Lennujaama tee Str 2, Tallinn) from 18:00 to 19:45 on Thursday, May 24.

**The team managers' meeting**, organized in accordance with the art. 1.2.087 of the UCI CR in the presence of the Members of the Commissaires' Panel, is scheduled for Thursday, May 24th at 20:00 in Hotel Ülemiste conference hall (Lennujaama tee Str 2, Tallinn).

***ARTICLE 5. Radio Tour***

The race radio frequency will be fixed by Estonian National Communications Board (ENCB) on 15.05.2012 at the latest and the participating teams will be informed about it in two weeks before the race.

The ENCB permission is needed for import and use of radio transmitters on the territory of Estonia.

***ARTICLE 6. Neutral Technical Support***

Neutral technical support will be organised by the sport equipment sales company HAWAII EXPRESS. Neutral service will be provided by 3 neutral technical service cars and 2 neutral service motorbikes.

***ARTICLE 7. Prizes for the final classification***

The following prizes are awarded:

Total value of prizes is 8686 €.

**ARTICLE 8. Sprinters prizes**

The intermediate sprints are in Järva-Jaani on 79,7 km and in Jõgeva on 129,1 km. The prizes for the three best of all sprints are:

1. 100 €
2. 65 €
3. 35 €

Total value of the prizes for intermediate sprints is 400 €.

To receive sprinters prizes, the rider has to finish the race within the time limit.

**ARTICLE 9. The best Young Riders´classification**

The best young rider is the rider, born after 1st of January 1990, who is placed on the best position in the final classification. The price for the best young rider is 100 €.

NB! ALL PRIZES NAMED IN ARTICLES 7 - 9 WILL BE PAID OUT LESS TAX:

1. 21% personal income tax according to Estonian Tax Law
2. 2% of the total prize fund by UCI Regulations to the CFAD
3. 7% of the total prize fund by UCI Regulations to the End of Career Fund.

According to UCI CR art. 1.2.072 the prizes shall be paid to the beneficiary´s or his team´s bank account no later than 90 days after the finish of the race. The bank transfer order will be based on the final classification and a special form with the beneficiary`s data, distributed by the organiser, which has to be filled in by the beneficiary before leaving the finish area.

**ARTICLE 10. Time limit**

Any rider(s), whose time gap with the **main group** will increase over 10 minutes during the race, must abandon because of safety reasons. Any rider finishing in a time exceeding that of the **winner** by more than 5% shall not be placed.

**Article 11. Antidoping**

The UCI antidoping regulations are entirely applicable to the event. The antidoping tests will take place at Turu 10, Tartu.

**ARTICLE 12. Awards ceremony**

In accordance with UCI CR art. 1.2.112 the following riders must attend the official ceremony: the best 3 riders of the event, the winners of the sprints and the winner in the Young Riders´ classification.

The riders will present themselves at the podium 15 minutes after crossing the finish line, approximately at 15:45.

**ARTICLE 13. Penalties**

The UCI penalty scale is the only one applicable.
