STATUTES for **BALTIC CUP 2012**

Time, venue, organizer:

The Baltic Cup 2012 will be organized in 3 Rounds
1 st Round – **in 9 th June, at 02.00 pm in Tartu, ESTONIA,**
2 nd Round – **in 4 th August, at 02.00 pm in Shiauliai, LITHUANIA,**
3 rd Round – **in 1 st September, at 02.00 pm in Valmiera, LATVIA.**

- **Riders.**

In Baltic Cup competitions every rider must be licensed by his host countries cycling federation or union. In BMX cycling for licencing procedure the plate numbers will be issue by following scale – **LATVIA from 19 – 349, Lithuania from 350 – 449, Estonia from 450 – 499.**The riders who are registrated for UEC competitions wear the plate number given by UEC.The riders age will be determined in the classes below according UCI age determination system.

CHALLENGE (11):

Boys - B 6 and younger; B 7–8; B 9–10; B 11–12; B 13–14; B 15–16,
Girls - G 8 and younger; G 9–10; G 11–12; G 13–14; G 15–16

CHAMPIONSHIP classes (4):

JM /JW 17–18;
EM/EW 19 + ;

AMATEURS (1):

Men M17 and older (20")

CRUISERS)2)

CR- 12 and younger (24)
Cr- 30 and older (24")

Totally 18 clases

Entry fees per round:

In Challenge and Amateurs classes: **5 EUR**
CHAMPIONSHIP classes : **15 EUR**

The Baltic Cup **Rounds are open** for all other countries riders

- **Only Baltic countries riders** will come **into overall standings.**For overall standing will count 3 out of 3 rounds. To be part of the overall standing, riders have to be entered and present at least 2 rounds.
- Each country is allowed to delegate unlimited number of riders in all Challenge and Championship classes.

In overall standing after 3 rounds the Baltic Cup will be challenged in all Challenge, Championship and Amateur classes – 18 classes

- **Seeding, transfer system and starting position on the gate**

In the 1 st round the riders will be divided per motos as per UCI BMX Rule book from January 1st 2011. For the next rounds all riders will be divided per motos according the results in the round before.

- Minimum the five riders constitute a class. In case that in one of age classes the score of riders is less than 5 (for girls less than 3), then this class will be united with next age group in the same sex. In this case the scoring will be separated.

The competitions day scedule is following:

In 2 nd and 3 rd moto the riders make choice of the path according the results in moto before. After 1 st round a new overall standing will be calculated and used for the next rounds seeding.

• Scoring.

In all age groups classification is made after 3 motos+final.

In case if in age group are **more than 8** riders, then in motos the best riders receive doppelt points: 1st.place-3 points, 2 nd- 2 p, 3 rd -1p. and the winner per round is determined after the final race in his own age group per class.

In the „**A** „ **final** race the points will be given as follow: 1st.-20 p, 2nd-18 p, 3 rd-16, 4th-14, 5 th-12, 6 th-11, 7 th-10, 8 th-9 points.

In the „**B** „**final** race the points will be given as follow:9 th-8 points;10th-7;11th-6;12 th-5;13th-4;14th-3;15th-2;16th-1point. The winner in round is determined after the final race in his own age group per class.

In case that the score of riders per round are **less than 8** then in motos doppelt points are not given and the winner per round will be determined by highest spot points after 3 motos and final race. If after 3 motos plus final race the earned spot points for two or more riders are equally then the winner is appointed after placing in final race.

In this case after 3 motos and final race points for total scoring per round points will be given as follow: 1 st.-20p., 2 nd-18 p., 3 rd-16 p., 4 th-14 p., 5 th-12 p., 6 th-10 p., 7 th-8 p., 8 th-6points.

In case when in overall standing the points are equal then higher place will be given for rider who earn more 1 st., 2nd., 3 rd places etc. in rounds.

Awarding.

After every round the host organiser provide awards for best 3 /Three/ riders in every age group per classes.

In overall standing after 3 rounds the winners of first 3 places in all 18 classes must be awarded with Baltic Cups. After overall standings in Championships classes(EM, JM, EW, JW) the winners of first three places must be awarded additionally with prize money.

75% from entry fees in JM/JW un EM/EW (Championships) classes in every round must be given for Baltic Cup Race director (in 2012 it will be from Latvia) for collecting prize money fund for overall price money awarding.

Lithuanian, Latvian Cycling Federations and Estonian Cycling Union every support price money fund with donation in size 200.- Euro and must be transfered it to Latvian Cycling Federation till 10 th of August 2012.

Total prize money fund for overall awarding will be divided as follow– EM /EW – 65%, JM / JW – 35%. Then from EM/EW (Elite class) (65%) money fund 80% go for EM class and 20% for EW class. The same percentage must be used for Junior classes. The Junior Men/Junior

Women and Elite Men / Elite Women class winners in overall standing the prize money received according following scale of percents:

N.B.In case if in EM/EW or JM/ JW classes in any sex not full mentioned score of awardable riders as mentioned above, then in this case the rest prize money will be added for other sex group in the same class.

Financial duties.

The payment of judgment in every round must be supplied by host cycling federation/union of corresponding round according UCI BMX Rules and these statutes.

Doppelt duties of round organizers.

The organiser club of 1 st Round of „BALTIC CUP 2012” (from Estonia) must organize the opening ceremony with parade of participants per countries and must secure the lifting all three Baltic countries national flags in flag sticks with recording the song Baltic awake/Baltija mostas/ Ergake Baltimaa/Gundaja Baltija.

The 2 nd round (in year 2012 Lithuania) will start without opening ceremony.All three National flags are lifted on flag sticks before official trainings time.

In 3 rd Round (in year 2012 Latvia) after competitions must be organised the official clothing ceremony with parade of riders per countries with prize giving ceremony.The Team Managers must appoint best three riders from National Team for lay down the National flags with recording National anthems.First will be layed down Estonian flag, then Lithuanian and last Latvian flag.

The officials from all National Cycling Federations in their own national language declare the clothing of Baltic Cup 2012.

Deadline for Pre-Registration.

The deadline for pre-registration are for 1 st round- 7 th of June,2 nd round – 2 nd of August,3 rd round 30 th of August by e-mail - inga.jursone@inbox.lv to Chief Administrator.
